*Celebrant:*

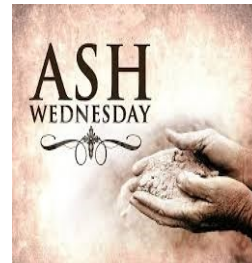
Give to the departed eternal rest, especially, .....
