Holy and Transcendent God, through Christ, you have revealed your divine glory in our humanity: Awaken your Church to see your presence manifested throughout the world, that we may serve you with a hope that acts with great boldness in your name. *Lord, in you mercy; hear our prayer.*

Lord, we pray, put your mark upon us today, give to us that which you desire us to have, and help us to share that which you desire us to share. Cast out, O Lord, our fear and anxiety, our turmoil and our trouble, and make us to shine with the radiance of your loving presence. *Lord, in you mercy; hear our prayer.*

God reigns enthroned over all: Let your glory be known among the leaders of our nation and all in authority in the world, that they may accomplish your purpose to establish equity and to execute justice and righteousness. *Lord, in you mercy; hear our prayer.*

Let your transfiguring light go forth into all the world to heal and comfort those who suffer from sadness, illness, poverty, injustice or oppression: Speak to them your healing words and give them the light of your countenance. *Lord, in you mercy; hear our prayer.*

Visit Holy Faith with your enlightening grace and reveal yourself as you did upon the holy mountain, that your brightness may shine forth from this place to the glory of your name. *Lord, in you mercy; hear our prayer.*
