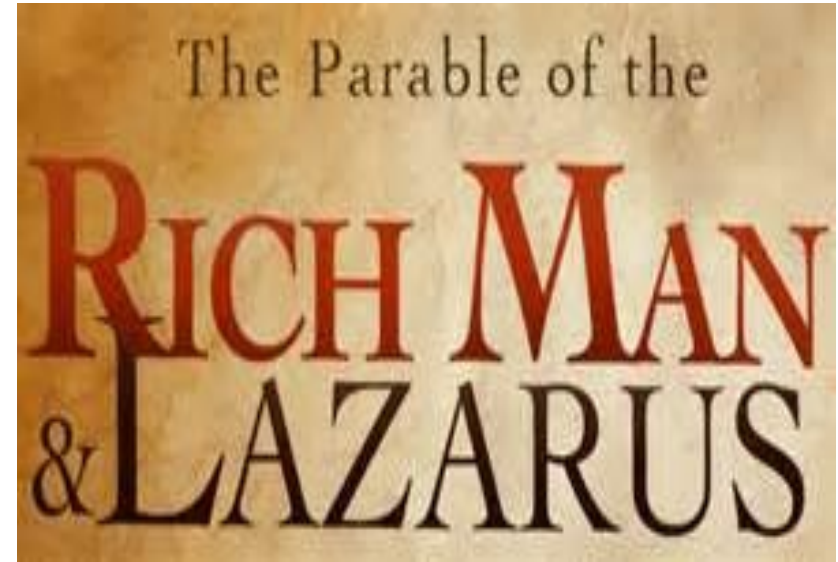

Celebrant:

Lord Jesus, as we have sang, so we pray. Help us to seek that vision of unity without which we would perish. Teach us not to deal with each other falsely, saying "Peace, peace" when there is no peace. Grant us grace that we may walk with our children, and with our brothers and sister, in the paths of righteousness, sharing with them that which is needful for life, both here in this world, and in the world to come.

Lord, hear our prayer.

Lord, we pray today for ministers and deacons and groups and agencies and for all those who work with the poor, for those who give fish so that others may eat for a day, and those who teach others to fish that they eat for a lifetime. ***Lord, hear our prayer.***

Lord, we pray for the poor of our nation, abundant in number, and for the poorer nations and peoples of the world, whose number seems overwhelming. Bless them through us, and bless them through the actions of our brothers and sisters around the world. Multiply the efforts of Your church, and of the relief agencies and organizations of our world. ***Lord, hear our prayer.***

Father, poverty and illness, starvation and homelessness, so often prevails where injustice is practiced, and has its roots in the love of money that individuals and nations have. So we pray, O Lord, that there may be justice in our world, and that the number of those who love money may diminish and the number who seek justice, and love mercy, and walk humbly with you, may increase. ***Lord, hear our prayer.***

We pray Lord for those who are struggling to make ends meet in this life, for friends and neighbors in times of hardship, for the church in its desire to stand by the impoverished and the oppressed. And for those whom we lift up before you now, O Lord, minister to them. ***Lord, hear our prayer.***

Almighty God, guide the people of the United States in the election of officials and representatives; that, by faithful administration and wise laws, the rights of all may be protected and our nation be enabled to fulfill your purposes. ***Lord, hear our prayer.***
